

# FIND YOUR RING SIZE

Before printing, ensure this guide is set to print at 100% scale and that you are printing on standard A4 paper (210mm x 297mm). If you are unsure as to whether you have printed the correct size, or if you are measuring on a screen, place a credit card on the guide.

## 1 METHOD

Choose a ring that would fit the desired finger.

Place the ring on the circles to the right. Align the inner edge of the ring with the nearest size circle. This measurement indicates the inner diameter of the ring.

If the ring falls between two sizes, choose the larger size.

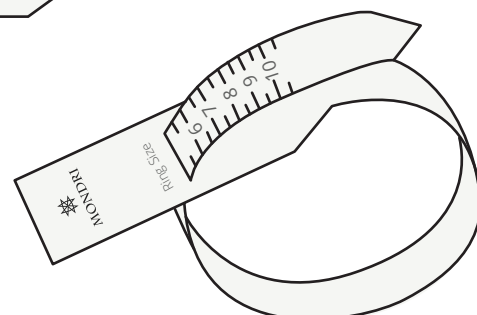
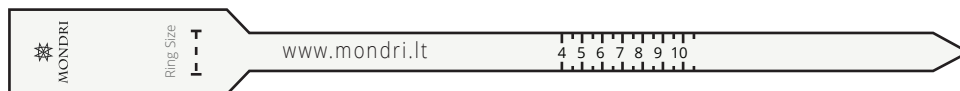
If you are choosing a pair of rings, always opt for the larger size

## 2 METHOD

The ring should fit comfortably and snugly on the finger so that it does not fall off, but there should also be enough space to slide over the finger.

Finger size changes depending on the time of day and weather, to get better results, measure your finger in the morning and at the end of the day. When fingers are warm and when they are cold. Fingers are smaller in cold weather.

Measure the finger size 3-4 times to avoid incorrect measurements.



- \* This ring size gauge is for indication only. Before purchasing, it is important to ensure that your ring size has been professionally measured. For 100% accurate sizing we do recommend you visit your local jeweller.
- \* Verify the result obtained in the MONDRI ring size guide table to choose the correct ring size, follow the data for the inner diameter in mm or inches.
